

Congratulations! You have successfully downloaded free Joomla template. This manual will show you how to install it correctly.

## Template package structure

- **joomla** - contains the joomla theme zip archive.
- **sources** - contains template source and additional files
- **readme.txt** - this manual
  - **to\_the\_root\_directory** - put the content of this folder to your Joomla root directory to make the template appear as at the preview
  - **psd** - contains template source PSD file.
  - **dump.sql** - import this file to your database to make the template appear as at the preview page

## Template Installation

To install Joomla template open your Joomla administration panel and go to Extensions > Extensions Manager. In the **Upload Package File** select your template file and click **Upload & Install** button.

When the installation is complete you'll be able to locate the template in the **Extensions > Templates Manager** section if your Joomla admin panel.

## Sample data installation

To make the template appear as at the preview you can install template sample content. Open **sources / to\_the\_root\_directory** folder and copy it's content to your Joomla installation root.

Open your database management tool (**phpMyAdmin**), select your database and in the Import section upload the **sources/dump.sql** file to your database.

Before the import please make sure your database tables prefix matches the one in the SQL file. Please do the following:

1. Open **configuration.php** file from the Joomla root directory
2. Using the search tool (CTRL+F) search for the **\$dbprefix** and check it's value
3. Open SQL file from the template '**sources**' directory and using **Search & Replace** tool in your editor replace all instances of **jos\_** with the \$dbprefix value from the configuration.php file

**Installing dump.sql file to your database will reset your website data so all your articles, module and website settings will be replaced with sample ones. Do not install if you have a working live website.**
